Dr. Meropi Toumba was born in Nicosia and is a Pediatrician specialized in Pediatric Endocrinology. She works in the private sector as a Pediatric Endocrinologist. She is a Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the Medical School of the University of Nicosia and a visitor scientific collaborator at the Cyprus Institute of Neurology & Genetics.

Dr. Meropi Toumba graduated with honors from Paphos High School A'. She earned her medical degree with distinction and completed her Pediatric specialty training at the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in Greece. In 2004, she served as a scientific associate at Makarios Hospital in Nicosia. The same year, she was awarded with the Clinical Fellowship by the European Society for Pediatric Endocrinology and trained at Great Ormond Street Hospital Children's Charity and the University College London Hospital in the UK. From 2005 to 2007, she worked as a researcher at the Institute of Child Health in London.

Dr. Toumba is a member of the European Network for Genetic imprinting Disorders and Rare Endocrine Diseases. She has contributed to the development of International Guidelines for Silver-Russell Syndrome and is the reference expert for this syndrome in Mediterranean and Balkan countries. As a scientific collaborator at the Cyprus Institute of Neurology & Genetics, she participates in research projects focusing on growth, puberty, obesity and adrenal disorders. Her academic contributions include over 40 publications with more than 1700 citations.

Dr. Meropi Toumba is a member of pediatric and endocrinology scientific societies in Cyprus and Europe and serves as a Board Member of the Cyprus Endocrine Society.
